- Mary Ellen McLean - Praised apparel for the colors and designs
- Treasurer Report - Debra
 - Ornament Sales \$480 (purchased for \$600 - there is still some to sell)
 - Food and Drink \$1,032 - \$500 less than last year. There seemed to be a lot left over. Pull pork was left, which never happens, which then left a lot of buns. Drinks were also left over.
 - Ladies Basket \$1,638 just about the same as last year.
 - Basket of Cheer \$578 slightly higher than last year - but sold on Saturday and Sunday.
 - 50/50 \$2,186 about \$400 more than last year. Saturday is a bigger day.
 - Apparel \$416 net. Much lower than last year. There is apparel left over.
 - Total Income 2025 @ 9500 but not all expenses are in yet, 2026 is projected to be less.
 - We may want to evaluate if we can get Seaside Bus for cheaper, as the price continuing to increase and coming in above budget
- Katie Brennan - Bathroom is essential, full size bus is needed with bags and waters, chaperones, costs continue to increase, we may have to increase budget for 2027
